The internship program at WCTV-14 is a hands-on, real-world experience to help educate future industry professionals. The ideal candidate is moderately experienced in video production, organized and detail oriented with a good work ethic and a willingness to learn. WCTV is seeking interns that can begin working without significant training. WCTV was incorporated in 1984 and has been serving the community of Wethersfield for forty years with great programming, volunteers, and free public access.

Eligibility Requirements


- Enrolled college students either community college or four-year college/university
- Preferred major in: Mass Communications, Video Production, TV/Video/Radio, or Marketing
- Good written and verbal communication skills
- Work independently and as part of a team. Works well with people and the general public.
- Must be ambitious and can communicate with all age groups

Expectations for WCTV Interns

- Make a three-month commitment, unless otherwise arranged
- Work an average of 3-5 hours per week unless more is required from your school.
- Knowledge of nonlinear editing software
- Some basic knowledge of Tri-caster taping equipment, Podcasting, Dropbox
- Familiarity with social media platforms- Instagram, Facebook, Snapchat, Twitter, YouTube
- Have good people skills and willing to help in all aspects of running a public access studio

Responsibilities/Outcomes include:

- Use production skills, including directing, operating a camera, editing, and mixing audio, to create content for WCTV's channels and social media.
- Assist in studio and on-location production as needed.
- Work collaboratively with staff to develop, plan, and schedule video productions.
- Learn and operate all field and studio equipment as well as be available for on location shoots
- Assist volunteers and Community Groups in their Productions
- Help re-build and maintain the Community Bulletin Board
- Make DVD Copies of the Programs as requested.
- Create graphics for Shows
- Create an Original Special, Show or Podcast-A required outcome
- Shoot and edit programs in a timely manner using Adobe Premiere or Final Cut Pro
- Website design, updating, and uploading videos
- Publicize upcoming shows and events as well as advertise previously created series
- Reach out to community through local newspapers and online forums to draw in volunteers
- Upload edited videos to Telvue (our scheduling system), our YouTube channel and website
- A Certificate of Successful Completion will be provided at the end

Compensation: This is an unpaid internship; it is a credit and/or volunteer program for students with basic equipment experience. We office open office hours with a flexible schedule.

Outcomes: Outlined under Responsibilities. A certificate of successful completion will be provided at the end of the internship. It is the student's responsibility to keep track of hours worked to meet any requirements by their school, which will be reviewed by WCTV14 and signed-off on if required.
